

Chris Nowinski, cofounder and CEO of the Massachusetts-based Concussion Legacy Foundation, posted a video of the hit on Twitter and called the NFL's concussion protocol "a fraud."

Nowinski wrote that Brissett showed "the clearest concussions (sic) signs of the season."

"Helmet-to-helmet hit, holds head, then goes

limp, then needs help up," he wrote. "You don't need a protocol to hold this player out for the game. Check the tape."

Brissett was not permitted to speak to the media after the game. A training tent for exami-Colts spokesperson told reporters that he developed concussionlike symptoms after the game.




